6. Elections
Describes election process
7. Assembly of Grand Council
Describes rules around meetings of the Grand Council
8. Law Making Procedures
Describes laws and law making process
9. Institutions
Describes governing institutions and authorities
10. Dispute Resolution
Describes dispute resolution process
11. Financial Administration
Describes financial management and administration
12. Relationship of laws, appeal and redress
Describes appeal and recall process
13. Constitutional Amendment

Describes the process to amend the constitution
